3. The general situation

- · Compared with the same period of the previous fiscal year, our sales became 106.7% in January.
- As to audio visual products, our sales of flat-panel TVs was better, and sales of DVD/BD recorders and memories audio was steady, though sales of CD/DVD soft was slightly stagnant.
- As to home appliances, our sales of air conditioners was better, and sales of other home appliances products such as refrigerators, washing machines and cooking device was generally steady.
- As to information communications equipment products, our sales of digital compact camera and mobile phones was better, and sales of pc and its relating products was also steady.
- As to other products, sales of TV games, toys, and liquors was better, and sales of watch and sporting goods was also steady.
